Singapore Tyler Print Institute (STPI) A new Docent Training Programme will be offered in 2010

Commencing 25th February 2010, this short, focused training programme will equip participants to guide visitors through the print and paper making workshops at STPI as well as the special exhibitions of work created at STPI by Visiting Artists.

Participants will learn about STPI and the Visiting Artist programme; the details of Western-style papermaking; and the four basic printmaking techniques – relief, intaglio, lithography, and screen printing. The course will consist of talks, demonstrations and hands-on workshops over a period of five weeks. Reading and art materials will be provided.
